This is a Red sweat shirt, White T shirt, black trouser or skirt and black shoes.

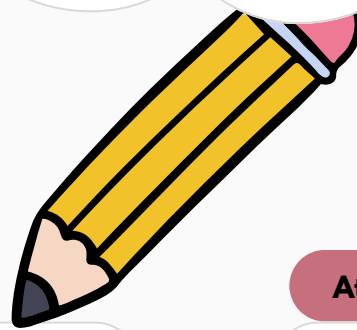
We have an increase in children wearing trainers and tracksuit bottoms, this is not required uniform.
