Chaplaincy and Mini Vinnie News

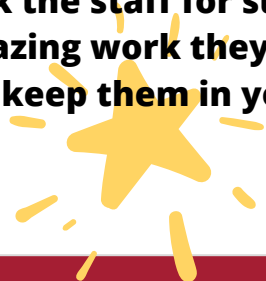
Ms Turner, took our Junior Chaplaincy Team and Mini Vinnie Team to Hull On Thursday for a Commissioning day.

A message from the Executive Head

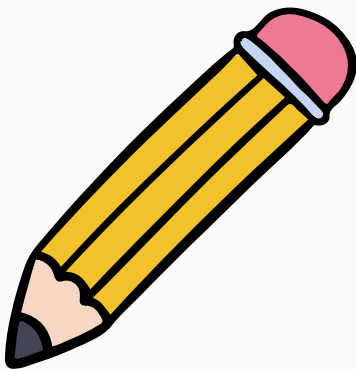

We have had a lot of complaints from our neighbours about parents parking over their driveways, at drop off and pick up times.

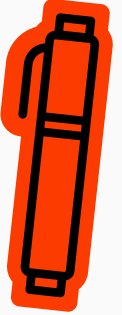
We understand they are busy times of day however we still need to be respectful of local residents.

Celebration of the Word

And James and John the sons of Zebedee, come to him, saying: Master, we desire that whatsoever we shall ask, thou wouldst do it for us: But he said to them: What would you that I should do for you?
