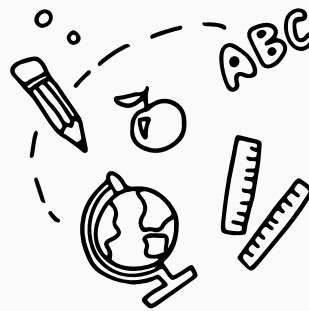

Individual and Family School Photos will be taking place on Friday 27th in the School Hall. from 8am.

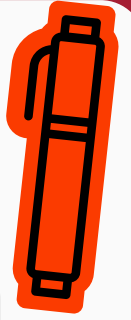

I hope you have a good weekend and look forward to seeing you all next week





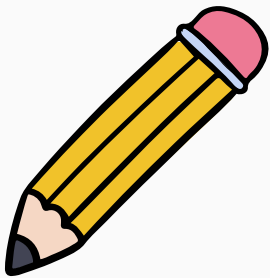
Safeguarding
