Fun in the Snow

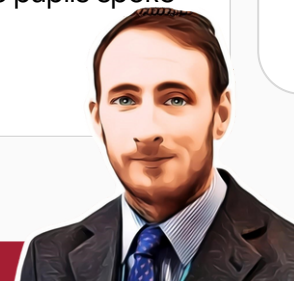
On Wednesday we had lots of fun outside in the snow. The children built lots of Snowmen and showed great teamwork and resilience to the cold.

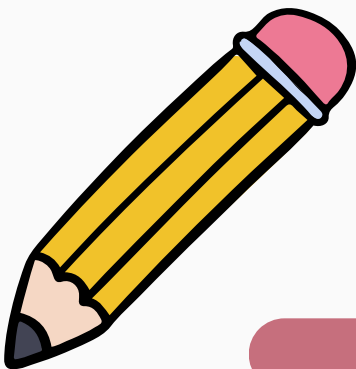
Uniform
